Pre-Installation Considerations

Pre/Post Installation Overview

The pre-installation routine will save a copy of the site's DENTAL CPT CODE MAPPING (#228) file in a temp global. After installing the file with data, the post-installation routine will restore the fields that the site is allowed to define at the local level (\$ values, etc). The post-install will also send a message to DENTV ADA CODE MAPPING (#228) mail group to tell them about the Code Mapping changes.

The pre-installation routine will delete fields 3,4,5,6,7 in file 220 and the associated data (there should be none, this is a precaution). It will also delete the DD for file 228.

The post-installation routine will "un-delete" any previous deleted transactions performed by non-admin users that were deleted in error and will reset field #.14 TIME COUNTER in file 228.2 to ensure uniqueness for a transaction or set of transactions. It will then verify the TIME COUNTER field for group type transactions (bridges, partials, etc).

*Note: If the patch is installed more than once, then the pre-init will not rerun to delete file 220 field data, but will only save off file 228 data.

The following Post-Installation step needs to be completed for this patch to work properly!

After the KIDS install has completed, IRM needs to place the DRM Plus executable (dentalmrmtx.exe) in the appropriate directory. **There is NO client side (workstation, thin client server, Citrix Server, etc) set up for this patch!

Installation Procedure

Dent_1_2p57.zip is a zip file that must be retrieved from one of the VA download sites. The preferred method is to FTP the file from download.vista.med.va.gov, which will transmit the file from the first available FTP server.

The file may also be downloaded directly from a particular FTP location at the following locations.

This patch should be installed when there are no dental DRM processes running. All open DRM Plus GUI applications should be closed (no users should be using the application). It is recommended to install this patch after hours due to the post-install conversions.

It is not necessary to disable any DENTV* options.

Install Time: approximately 5 minutes, depending on the number of records in file 220.

The post-install will be queued, but will take time to perform all of its functions. Users should not access DRM Plus until the job completes.

1. LOAD A DISTRIBUTION

Obtain the Dent_1_2P57.kid file from the Dent_1_2p57.zip file.

Start up the Kernel Installation and Distribution System Menu [XPD MAIN], select the Installation menu, then Load a Distribution and enter the Kids name (Note: You may need a directory name in front of the kids build).

2. PERFORM OPTIONAL STEPS

On the Installation Menu, the following are OPTIONAL:

- a. Backup a Transport Global This option will create a backup message of any routines exported with this patch. It will not backup any other changes such as DD's or templates.
- b. Compare Transport Global to Current System This option will allow you to view all changes that will be made when this patch is installed. It compares all components of this patch (routines, DD's, templates, etc.).
- c. Verify Checksums in Transport Global This option will allow you to ensure the integrity of the routines that are in the transport global.
- **3. INSTALL PACKAGE(s): -** When prompted for the INSTALL NAME, enter **DENT*1.2*57:**
 - a. Choose the **Install Package**(s) option to start the patch install.
 - b. When prompted 'Want KIDS to INHIBIT LOGONs during the install? NO//' answer NO.
 - c. When prompted 'Want to DISABLE Scheduled Options, Menu Options, and Protocols? NO//' answer NO.

Post-Installation Procedures

- 1. **Move dentalmrmtx.exe to** ...**DOCSTORE** (replace existing file) '...\' indicates your path for where DRM Plus is located. The version of the new exe is V5.7.0.23 dated 5/21/2009
- Move drm-plus.chm to ...\DOCSTORE\HELP (replace existing file) '...\' indicates your path for where DRM Plus is located The file is dated 8/12/2009
- 3. Move the spell check dictionaries american.adm and medical.adm to the Dictionaries folder ...\DOCSTORE\Dictionaries

'...\' indicates your path for where DRM Plus is located. You do not have to replace existing files and you may need to create the Dictionaries folder if it does not exist.

Note: there is no workstation, thin client server, etc. setup to perform for this patch!

The post-installation routine runs in a background job and performs the following functions:

- a. Restores file 228 site specific data (\$ values, etc)
- b. Un-deletes any 'marked as deleted' completed dental data in file 228.2 that was incorrectly deleted by non administrative dental users
- c. Resets the 228.2 field .14 Time counter field so that incorrect deletions will no longer occur.
- d. Verifies group transaction (bridges, partials, etc) Time Counter fields.
