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Introduction

Clinical Reminder UPDATE_2_0_13 contains 1 Reminder Exchange entry:

UPDATE_2_0_13 VA-COMBINATION DRUG CLASSES CROC

VA facilities reported that the Computerized Patient Record System (CPRS) did not trigger allergy-drug order checks for orders of combination medications that contained a drug similar to a listed allergen. The allergy-drug order checks were also not presented in VA's Veterans Health Information Systems and Technology Architecture (VistA) for pharmacy review.

VA-COMBINATION DRUG CLASSES CLINICAL REMINDERS ORDER CHECK (CROC) will generate an order check that provides a warning to perform a manual allergy assessment for the following combination drug classes when ordered:

CV400 - ANTIHYPERTENSIVE COMBINATIONS
DE250 - ANTI-INFECTIVE/ANTI-INFLAMMATORY COMBINATIONS, TOPICAL
GA802 - ANTIMUSCARINIC/ANTIPASMODIC COMBINATIONS
OP350 - ANTI-INFECTIVE/ANTI-INFLAMMATORY COMBINATIONS, TOPICAL
OPHTHALMIC
OT250 - ANTI-INFECTIVE/ANTI-INFLAMMATORY COMBINATIONS, TOPICAL
OTIC
RE500 - COLD REMEDIES, COMBINATIONS

In Reminder Exchange, navigate to the exchange entry named **UPDATE_2_0_13 VA-COMBINATION DRUG CLASSES CROC** using SL Action. Once you find your entry, you will use IFE Action to install the entry. In this example, entry 102 will be used to install, it will vary by site.
